## Analyst, Integrated Data

Reporting to the Decision Support Services Administrator – Data Integration, you will perform routine data extraction, transformation and loading activities related to key decision support applications as well as participate in the design, writing, and production of standard and ad hoc reports/queries utilizing the data stored in those applications. In this role, you will have multiple responsibilities, one of which is to identify problems and offer innovative solutions while documenting these applications and maintaining dictionaries/tables. Another key responsibility is to ensure the routine availability of integrated patient specific data for various projects. This role provides an excellent opportunity to gain valuable insight into hospital operations via investigation of patient flow and the use of related service data for the purposes of activity tracking, utilization management, business intelligence and patient costing activities.

You hold a degree in Health Information Science from a recognized school plus one to three years related work experience. Your extensive background includes a strong understanding of relational database concepts. In particular, you are highly proficient with Structured Query Language (SQL) in a Microsoft SQL Server environment (Enterprise Manager, SQL Query Analyzer and Data Transformation Services). It is crucial in this role that you have the ability to perform advanced data processing, analysis and report writing using tools such as SQL Server, Access, Excel and Crystal Reports. An understanding of hospital operations and data quality management would be a definite asset.
